 But if a slave, or slaves, thin upon Complaint made as aforesaid -
 the said Justice shall Issue out his warrant to the Master or Owner
 of such slave, or slaves, tharby Comauning him or them to deliver up such
 slave or slaves to receive his or their due and deserved punishment upon
 the penalty of forfeiting the Mulet aforesaid

And it is further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that if any person
 or persons whatsoever shall by travelling in the highways or roads in
 this Island with fire lighted torches or smearing Tobacco or otherwise
 enter into the standing sugar Cries, or wadding, or going a Cabbing in
 the Barricadoes or Plantations of any person or persons whatsoever in this
 Island with fire lighted torches, or lighted Pipes of Tobacco where such
 Cries are growing, and shall wilfully or carelessly give the same, -
 that such Offender or Offenders shall upon the fact proved by two
 sufficient Witnesses suffer death as a Felon, any Law Custome or
 usage heretofore used or made to the contrary in any wise notwith-
 standing Dated the fourteenth day of August One thousand six
 hundred seventy five

5. An Act concerning those that remove
 from one Division to another without a
 Ticket from the Command of the Division

It is Ordered and Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that
 no person or persons whatsoever Inhabiting or residing upon this
 Island shall after the publication hereof remove, or change their
 habitation from one Division to another, but hee shall be obliged to take
 a Ticket or Certificate from the Captayne or Commander of the Company or
 Division from whence hee removeth, to the Captayne or Commander of the
 Division whither hee goeth to settle, which Ticket or Certificate hee shall
 deliver or raise to be delivered to the Captayne or Command of the Division
 whither hee removeth within three days after hee coming thither
 And whosoever shall neglect to do soe shall forfeit for every such
 offence One hundred pounds of Tobacco, and it is further ordered and
 Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that every Capt or Commander to
 whom

Whome such Ticket shall be delivered shall retorne in the name
of the party (if a freeman) into the Sheriffs office within
six dayes after the receipt thereof, or before the next generall Court
ponally of forfeiting and paying for every omission one hundred
of Tobacco.

An act against indebted Runaways suing for their Credits by Attornys

Whereas diverse indebted persons by Attornys have
greate prejudice of their Credits fled from this Island and
have sought to recover by Attornys to the use of other Men
what is any way owing unto them in this Island, and so
fraudulently convert it to their owne and other uses to the utter
defrauding of their Credits. Be it therefore Enacted ordered
Established by the Authority aforesaides That noe person or
whatsoever that heretofore have, or hereafter shall depart this Island
without publishing their names, and taking out their Tickets
according to the Lawes and Customes thereof shall after the
publication thereof sue or recover in the Court of this Island any
Debt due unto them by bill bonds specialties Assignments or
otherwise by virtue of any Letter of Attornay or Assignments
excepte the Attornay or Assignes suing for such Debt and
will putt sufficient Caution into the Court to be answerable
make satisfaction for the Debt & Credits or Credits of the said
fugitive whatsoever shall be demanded or proved due by the
Attornay, or Assignes, or any of them.
