

29 But if a slave, or slaves, shun upon complaint made as aforesaid -
the said Justice shall issue out his warrant to the Master or Owner
of such slave, or slaves, thrally commanding him or them to deliver up such
slave or slaves to receive his or their due and deserved punishment upon
the penalty of forfiting the Master aforesaid

And it is further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that if any person
or persons whatsoever shall by travelling in the highways or roads in
this Island with fire, lighted torches or smoaking tobacco or otherwise
enter into the Standing Sugar Cages, or wadding, or going a robbing in
the Cannibals or Plantations of any person or persons whatsoever in this
Island with fire lighted torches, or lighted pipes of Tobacco where such
cages are growing, and shall willfully or carelessly fire the same, -
That such Offender or Offenders shall upon the fact proved by two
sufficient Witnesses suffer death as a Felon, any Law custome or
usage heretofore had or made to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding
standing dated the fourteenth day of August One thousand six
hundred sevnty five

An Act concerning those that remove from one Division to another without a Ticket from the Command of the Division

It is Ordered and Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that
no person or persons whatsoever inhabiting or residing upon this
Island shall after the publication hereof remove, or change their
habitation from one Division to another, but he shall be obliged to take
a Ticket or Certificate from the Captain or Commander of the Company or
Division from whence he removeth, to the Captain or Commander of the
Division wher he goeth to settle, which Ticket or Certificate he shall
deliver or cause to be delivered to the Captain or Commander of the Division
whither he removeth within three days after his coming thither
and whosoever shall neglect to do so shall forfeit for every such
offence One hundred pounds of Tobacco, and it is further ordered and
Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that every Cap't or Commander to
whom

whome such Ticket shall be delivered shall returne in the
of the party (if a Freeman) into the Secretaries Office ^{within}
six dayes after the receipt whereof, or before the next generall Court
ponalty of forfeiting and paying for every omission One hundred ^{per}
of Tobacco. /

gle have sought to recover by Attorneys to the uses of other Men
what is any way owing unto them in this Island, and occa-
sionally convert it to their owne and other uses to the utter-
debauching of their Credit^s Bee it therefore Enacted ordered
Established by the Authority aforesaid That noe person or
whatsoeuer that heretofore have, or hereafter shall depart this Island
without publishing their names, and setting out their Estates
attending to the Laws and Customes therof shall after the
publication hereof sue or recover in the Court of this Island
Debt due unto them by Bills Bonds specialties, Accounts or
otherwise by virtue of any Letter of Attorney or Assignee
except the Attorney or Assignee suing for such Debt and
will putt sufficient Caution into the Court to be answerable
make satisfaction for the Debts & Credit^s or Credit^s of the said
fugitives for whatsoeuer shall be demanded or proved due by the said
fugitive, or fugitives, or any of them. /
