

An Act against Enticing servants from their Masters

It is Declared ordered and Enacted by the Governor Council and
the Deputies on behalf of this Island, And it is hereby Declared ordered
and Enacted that whosoever after the publication hereof shall by
himself or others persuade Juine or seek to withdraw any hired or
Contract servant Slave or Slaves belonging or appurtening to any
other person or persons whatsoever Inhabiting residing or habiting
upon this Island, or shall propound the buying or purchasing of the
said or persons of any servant or slave to the said
servant or slave without having first acquainted the proprietor of
Masters or Command of the said servant or slave with his Injunction and
Concludd and bargained with the said Master Command or proprietor
of the said servant for and touching the time and person of the said
servant or slave, or that after the refusal of the said Master proprietor
or Command shall in any sort directly or indirectly by himself or others
permebly, either persuade, or otherwise dole with or cause to be
dole with any such Contract servant, servant or slaves, who by such
servant or slave shall be enticed withdrawn, or any way alienated
from, or any way made unfit in his or her Will or affection for the
service and employ of his or her Master or any other to whose Care and
Charge they are left or Intrusted by the Master or Owner of them or either
of them, or shall by any Language word or discourse discourage the
servant or slave of any other person or persons to whom he said
servant or slave doth or shall appurten that then the said person or
persons for offending being free shall for every such offence not only
forfeite by reason of his offence to be recovered at the Common Law by
the Master or Owner of the said servant or slave one thousand p^{ts}
of good Tobacco or Sugar, but shall also forfeite five hundred p^{ts}
of like Tobacco or Sugar to be levied by way of Districte to the
publique use of this Island, And if in case the party offending
have not then said goods nor Chattels to make satisfaction to the
party grieved for his damage, then to the publique for his Mulets,
then to performe the party grieved six Months service at the
appointment of the said party, or to lye in prison until he hath otherwise
satisfied the said Damage, or in lieu of the said five hundred p^{ts}
of Tobacco or Sugar aforesaid, if he cannot otherwise discharge it, to
performe three Months Labor or service in some publique Work at
the

the appointment of the Governour for the time being and the Major

An Act against the unlawfull practising
of Physicians Chirurgens and Doctors

Forasmuch as diverse persons coming to this Island from all parts
of his Majesties Dominions who are necessitated to take upon them to be some
profession or other the better to gaine a lively hood and subsistence, and
amongst other many persons to be Chirurgens and Apothecaries both -
which professions next runne attaine to but by great experience and
labour care and study, yett under the Denomination and Title will take
upon them to practise and Administer both Internally and Externally
which through their ignorance and unskillfullnesse oftentimes prove fatall
and destructive to their Patients, And the said persons under that name
seek to invade and skinn the Doying of such a just in many things -
relating to the Civill Government as the Military affairs of this Island,
which to prevent and Avoid for the future It is declared and Enacted and
so it hereby declared and Enacted that no person or persons whatsoever
that now are or which hereafter shall happen to arrive on this Island
shall take upon him or them to practise or Administer Physicke either
Externally or Internally under nor such pretence or Title until such
person or persons shall first have with the Governour or Governour for the
time being and obtained a License to practise in this Island in the
profession aforesaid And he it further Enacted by the Authority
aforesaid that the Governour that now is nor any hereafter for the time
being shall Authorize or License any such person or persons to practise
as aforesaid until he or they be examined by the Governour and Council or
the Major part of them in his or their skil knowledge and Judgment
in the said professions or either of them, who shall well approve and
allow of the same before such License and Toleration shall be
granted as aforesaid unless the said person or persons soe deservinge
liberty to practise shall produce a Certificate from the Chirurgens Hall in
London or a Certificate from any University or able Physician of any of his
Majesties Kingdomes for his being admitted and allowed off, of that
