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ANTIGUA:

An Act for the better Government of Slaves and free Negroes. 12° 130. May, 1703.

E your Majefty's most loyal, dutiful, and obedient Subjects, the Governor in Chief of your Majesty's Leeward Charibbee Islands, and the Council and Affembly of this your Majefty's Island of Antigua, humbly pray your most Sacred Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it, and it is hereby enacted by the Authority of the fame, That no Perfon whatfo-ever fhall give leave on the *Sabbath* Day to any Slave under his or her Care, to go without Charge, or Ownerfhip (unlefs fuch as ufually wait on their Perfon, or in Li-Perfon on Sunveries) to go out of their Plantations, without a Ticket, or White Servant days, on Pe-nalty of 3s. with them, in which Ticket is to be expressed the Names and Numbers, and alfo to and from what Place, on Penalty of paying, for taking up fuch Slave or Slaves as Runaways, Three fhillings.

II. AND be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That any Per- Detaining an-other's Slave fon, who fhall take up any Slave or Slaves belonging to another, and fhall above 24 Hours keep the faid Slave or Slaves in his or their Cuftody or Plantation longer than Diem; Twenty four Hours, without fending the faid Slave or Slaves to the Owner or Owners they belong to (if he or they can any Ways know them) or with-out delivering the faid Slave or Slaves to the Provoft Marshal of this Island for the time being, shall for every Day each Slave as shall be kept or entertained by him or them, after the first Twenty four Hours, forfeit Twelve Shillings per Diem, and, if the faid Slave be of any Trade, Twenty four Shillings if a Tradefinan per Diem, for each Day fuch Slave or Slaves shall be by him or them knowingly entertained or imployed; if under Six Pounds, to be recovered before any If under 6 l. III. AND if any Perfon shall privately delude, entice, or perfuade any Slave to pay the like, or Slaves, being in quiet Possessient of another, out of his or their Custody, by and to be reco-any Encouragement or Inducement whatsoever, shall be liable to the same vered as before. Penalty of every Day, the faid Slave or Slaves shall, by their Means or Procurement, desert their Owners or Masters Service, as in case of entertaining a Runaway longer than Twenty four Hours, to be recovered after the fame Manner; but in cafe any Perfon shall violently, or by force, or otherwife, by Violence take any Perfon's Slave or Slaves out of his or their Plantation or Custody, shall deemed Robbe deemed guilty of Robbery, and indicted as in Cafes of Robbery; and in Endeavouring cafe any Perfon or Perfons shall take away any Slave or Slaves, or endeavour to carry him off the Island, Feto carry off from this Island, or delude away from their Owners, shall be guilty lony without of Felony, and excluded the Benefit of Clergy.

AND be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That any Perton, Sec. unless fon who shall deal with any Slave or Slaves for any Sugar, Cotton, or Toby Owner's leave, Offender bacco, or any other Goods whatfoever, without leave given from the Owner bound to Sef- of the faid Slave or Slaves everythe back of the states of the faid slave of slaves everythe back of the states of the faid Slave or Slaves, exprest by a Note, or some White Person (which Note or White Perfon shall specify what Goods he shall so fell, and the Quantity) and that none prefume to deal with any Slave, otherwife than as is before directed, under the Penalty that fuch Perfon fo offending, shall be bound over by the next Justice to the good Behaviour, until the next Seffions of the . Peace, or General Seffions, and there to be fined, or receive fuch other Punishment, as the Juffices shall think convenient.

V. AND that all Negroes who shall (though with a Ticket or other leave from their Owners or Poffeffors) fell any Thing, in any of the Towns on the Lord's Day, he or they shall be taken up and whipped, and paid for as Runaways, if not returned, or going to their refpective Masters by Ten of the Clock, to the Intent that all opportunities of Idleness and Robbery may be taken away.

VI. AND if any flurdy Slave fhould impudently flrike or oppose any White Perfon, any Juffice, upon Complaint or Proof made, shall order a Con-Itable to caufe fuch Slave to be publickly whipped, at their Difcretion; and if if a White Per- fuch White Perfon be any Way hurt, wounded, or disfigured by any Slave's Refiftance, fuch offending Slave or Slaves shall have their Nose flit, or any Membe flir or Mem. ber cut off, or be punished with Death, at the Difcretion of the Juffices; always excepting, That fuch Slave do not the fame by his or her Owner's or Ma-fter's Order, or in Defence of his or her Person or Goods; and it shall be lawful for all Persons to take away from any Slaves, any hurtful Clubs or other mischievous Weapons whatfoever, unless fuch Slave or Slaves have any Marshal or De-puty to receive Charge of their Owner's or Master's Goods to defend. all Runaways, VII. VIII. AND in cafe the faid Marshal shall willfully or neglectfully suffer an Escape any Way whatsoever, of the Slave by him received, or imploy him in any Work, he shall pay the Owner, as in case of any Persons detaining another's Slave above Twenty four Hours, until fuch Slave be delivered the Owner, or forfeit Fifty Pounds current Money; and in cafe any Slave perish in Cu-stody for want, he shall forfeit Fifty Pounds like Money; the Marshal to have Three Shillings for taking fuch Slave into his Cuftody, and Twelve pence each Twenty four Hours the Slave lies in Prison; as also upon the Marshal's Delivery of any Slave or Slaves to his Owner or Poffeffor, the Sum of Three Shillings, befides Nine Pence per Mile, which the Bringer of the faid Slave or Slaves has received from the Provost Marshal or his Deputy.

IX. AND if any Slave or Slaves lie to long as Three Months, fuch Slave or Slaves is to be taken out, and fold at out-cry for the Fees, by Order of Two Juffices of the Peace, and the Overplus, if any be, after the paying the aforefaid Fees, and all the above mentioned Charges, shall be returned to the Owner, or, for want of knowing fuch Owner, to the Treasurer for the time being, to remain to the Use of the Publick, till the Owner shall appear; and the Provost Marshal, or his Deputy, shall be obliged upon Oath to account, and

AND it is also enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That any Perfon Perfons taking taking up a Runaway, and knowing his Mafter, either by the Slave's Confef- to carry him to fion, or otherwife, fhall, on Penalty of Forfeiture of Forty Shillings, carry fuch known, under Slave fo known, or caufe him to be carried to his Mafter or Owner, and not Penalty of 40 4. to the Gaol or Marshal, unless the Owner be unknown to him; and if any owner refuling Owner or Master shall refuse to pay Three Shillings for taking such Slave to pay 3, and one multiple of the part o up, and Nine Pence per Mile, for the Diftance he was taken up at (be- to forfeit 40. ing brought to him) shall, besides the faid Fees, forfeit Forty Shillings.

XI. AND if any Marshal or Deputy shall deny to deliver any Slave in his Marshal detain-Cuftody on tender of his due Fees and Difburfements, he shall lose his Fees, tender of Fees and forfeit Forty Shillings befides, each Refufal, and pay as in cafe of wrong to forfeit 40 s. detaining another's Slave for each Day detained.

XII. AND it is further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That on Com- On Complaint plaint made to any Juffice of any Crime done by any Slave or Slaves, fuch mitring acrime Juffice shall iffue out his Warrant for apprehending the Offenders, and for Juffice may or all Evidences; if the faid Juffice find such Crime not Capital, he may appoint except in Capublick Correction of fuch Slave, according to Diferetion, and award Satisfaction to the Parties injured, not exceeding Six Pounds; but if the Crime be heinous, or the Damage greater than Six Pounds, then the faid Juffice shall commit the faid Offender to Prifon, or take Security, at his Difcretion, and then appoint a Day for the Witnefs to appear, which Crime, Day, and Time fuch Juffice is to certify to the next Neighbouring Juffice, who shall join with the aforefaid Justice at the Time and Day appointed, as aforefaid; which faid Two Juffices (according to the Evidences that shall be given before them) shall give Sentence as the Crime deferveth, and the faid Justices shall forthwith iffue out their Warrant for executing the faid Sentence, and fuch Juftices may, if they fee fit, condemn any Slave to the Party injured, until the Owner pay fuch Damage, as shall be by them adjudged to be paid to any Perfon injured.

XIII. XVI. AND for the future be it enacted, That what Slaves foever shall abfent themfelves from their Masters or Mistresses Service, during the Space of Three Months, or upwards, shall be punished with Death, loss of Limb, or Member, or publick Whipping, at the Difcretion of Two Juffices of the

Peace, whom the faid offending Slaves shall be brought before. XVII. A N D be it enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That the Owner of fuch Slave or Slaves, as shall be punished with Death for the Offence aforefaid, shall be fatisfied for the Loss of fuch Slave, Eighteen Pounds current Money, to be paid out of the Publick Treasury of this Island.

XVIII. AND be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That up-Publick Punish-ment to be paid on any Publick Punishment, that shall by Sentence of any Justice or Justices by Treadurer, if be inflicted by Virtue of this Act, the Charge incident thereto thall be born or exceeding by the Publick, and paid by the Treasurer by Order of the faid Justice or Justices, provided the fame exceed not Five Pounds current Money.

XIX. A N D be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That if any Perfon kill a Slave stealing, or in Pursuit of him, being a Runaway, and refuse to fubmit, fuch Perfon shall not be liable to any Profecution at Law; any Law,

Cuftom, or Usage to the contrary notwithstanding. XX. AND be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That if any Perfon whatfoever shall fell any Rum to a Slave on the Sabbath Day, or any fort of dry Goods, by Barter, or otherwife, he shall forfeit Three Pounds current Money for each Offence.

XXI. AND be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That all Penalties mentioned in this Act, and not directed how to be recovered and dif-Warrant to constable from posed of, if not more than Six Pounds in Money, shall be levied by a Justice's Warrant, directed to a Constable, who is, on Penalty of Forty Shillings for each Refusal, to execute all Warrants, and other Precepts directed to him, and to receive for his Pains Eight per Cent. out of the faid Forfeitures; and at above Six Pounds, to be recovered by Action of Debt in any Court of Record of this Island, and shall be One Half to the King, for the Use of the Publick of this Island, and the other Half to the Informer or Person fuing for the fame.

XXII. AND be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That all Erc. having no Land, to choose Free Negroes, Mulattoes, or Indians, not having Land, thall be obliged in Thirty Days after the Date hereof to choose some Master or Mistress to live with, who shall be owned by them, and with whom they shall live, and take their Abode, to the Intent that their Lives and Conversations may be known, to be called to their respective Duties; and if any Free Person, not being a White, shall prefume to strike a White Servant, he shall be by Order of the next Justice (on Proof of his striking) severely whipped, at the Discretion of the faid Juffice; and that all Perfons who are not Whites, and are fit to go out to Trades, shall be bound Apprentice to any Person that will receive them for Seven Years (unlefs they choose a Master or Mistrefs to be bound to) by the next Justice, who shall be informed of such Persons, and who is immediately to caufe them to be bound, in Ten Days after fuch Information,

to any willing to receive them, on Penalty of forfeiting Ten Pounds. XXIII. AND be it enacted by the Authority aforefaid. That for the fufkall posses acres of ture no Free Negro shall be Owner or Possessor of more than Eight Acres of Land, and in no Cafe shall be deemed and accounted a Freeholder: Al-Acres may fell of Land in his own Right, may within Six Months make Sale of the Over-it in 6 Months, plus of the faid Land, and, for want of Sale of the fait I Time, the faid Overplus above Eight Acres to be forfeited to the Queen.

A N D it is further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That if White Perfon any White Perfon shall strike, beat, or otherwise abuse any Free Negro, In-Negro, Sec. dian, or Mulatto, on Proof thereof made to any Justice of the Peace, he shall bound to set be bound over to the Sessions, and be punished at the Discretion of the punished.
