Exciting any perfons to cooperate with the enemy, Deemed felony without clergy.

1V. If any perfon or perfons within this colony, fhall, at any time after the paffing of this aft, compel, induce, perfuade or attempt to compel, induce, or perfuade, any white perfon or perfons, or any free negro, or negroes, mulatto or mulattoes, Indian or Indians, to defert from their habitation or habitations, or any negro, or other flave or flaves, to defert from his, or their mafter, miftrefs, or owner, and to join any land or naval force, raifed or to be raifed, or fent by Great-Britain, or any authority derived from that government, against the united colonies of America, or this colony, or to join any perfon or perfons, armed in a hoftile manner, with intent to oppofe, or fubvert the government of this colony effablished as aforefaid, or with intent of killing any perion or perfons, or deflroying his, her or their goods, or property, who fhall be atling, or ready and willing to aft, in fupport and defence of fuch government, or any of the inhabitants of this colony, and friends to the fame, every fuch perfon or perfons, fo offending in any of the above offences, and all fuch as fhall aid and abet, the faid offender or offenders, in the perpetration and execution of any of the faid offences, shall on conviction thereof, by due courfe of law, be deemed and adjudged guilty of felony, and fhall fuffer death without benefit of clergy. Provided, That nothing in this act contained fhall be confirued, or taken to prevent the good people of this colony from arming of flaves or negroes for the better defence of this colony, against all enemies whatfoever who shall invade or attack the fame, or endanger the fafety thereof.
